Third Thursday of March is High Five Day.

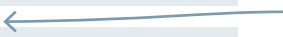

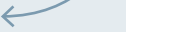
Second monday of January is Clean off Your Desk Day.

This day is also Fibonacci Day — sure, it is pretty geeky, but if you can sneak a fibonacci sequence into a post, some followers will notice and appreciate it.

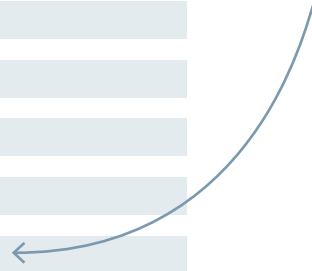
